



## Scenario: A Walk in the Park

### Characters

- **Esma, Nade, Iliana, Toni, Ile, Dime** – Children
- **Simona** – Teacher
- **Mite** – Boy with an electric scooter
- **Zora** – Police officer
- **Ali** – Judge

### Scene 1 – A Sunny Morning

It's a bright and cheerful day. Teacher **Simona** leads her kindergarten group—**Esma, Nade, Iliana, Toni, Ile, and Dime**—along the sidewalk toward the park. They walk carefully in a line and arrive safely.

**Teacher Simona:** Here we are, children! We walked slowly and carefully, and we've arrived at the park. Now you can play freely, but remember to be careful and kind.

**Children (together):** Okay, teacher! We'll play carefully.

### Scene 2 – A Game Begins

**Esma:** Friends, do you want to play "The Kitten Walks Past You"?

**Toni:** Yes, great idea! Let's choose who will be the kitten with a counting rhyme.

**Iliana:** Come on, Toni, tell us your favorite rhyme.

**Toni:**

*Eeny, meeny, miny, moe,*

*Catch a tiger by the toe.*

*If he hollers, let him go,*

*Eeny, meeny, miny, moe.*

**Ile:** Nade will be the kitten! Let's kneel in a circle and start the game.

**Nade:** *Kitten walks beside you, be careful it doesn't scratch you, keep the mouse's tail away from our kitten.* Come on, Dime, catch me!

(Dime starts chasing Nade around the circle. When Nade sits in Dime's spot, Dime becomes the new kitten.)

**Dime:** Now I'm the kitten!

### Scene 3 – Trouble in the Park

The children laugh and play while **Simona** watches from a bench. Suddenly, **Mite** zooms into the park on an electric scooter, riding too fast.

He loses control and veers off the path toward the lawn where the children are playing.



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**Teacher Simona (shouting):** Be careful, boy! Watch where you're going—you could hurt the children!

#### Scene 4 – A Conflict

**Mite (angrily):** Oh no! What are you doing here? Because of you, I fell! Stupid kids!

**Teacher Simona:** Watch your language, young man. It was your fault—you put everyone's safety at risk.

**Mite:** That's not true! You didn't teach your kids how to behave. I'm the one who's hurt, and my scooter is broken!

**Teacher Simona:** You're fine, Mite. Maybe next time, you'll pay more attention instead of blaming others.

(Mite storms off, frustrated. He returns a few minutes later, blasting loud music from a speaker.)

Nearby, **Police Officer Zora**, who has seen everything, approaches.

**Officer Zora:** Young man, please turn down the music.

**Mite:** No, I don't want to!

**Officer Zora:** You're disturbing public peace and endangering others.

**Mite:** But that teacher was mean! Her kids broke my scooter!

**Officer Zora:** I saw the whole thing, and it was your fault. You'll be fined for disturbing public order and safety.

#### Scene 5 – In the Courtroom

Later, **Simona**, **Mite**, **Officer Zora**, and **Judge Ali** meet in the courtroom.

**Judge Ali:** After reviewing the case, the court finds that Mite endangered public safety and disturbed public order. According to the law, anyone who behaves in a way that threatens the safety of others in a public place must face consequences.

Therefore, Mite, you are fined **500 euros** for your actions.

**Judge Ali (to everyone):** Let this be a reminder—

Everyone must be careful and responsible in public spaces.

Your safety and the safety of others depend on your behavior.



## Scenario: Corruption

### Characters

- **Driver (Child)**
- **Police Officer 1**
- **Police Officer 2**
- **Judge**

### Materials

Police costumes (2) • Fast car (toy or prop) • Police car (toy or prop) • Traffic lights • Road and footpath setup • Jail (corner or marked space) • Handcuffs • Judge's desk • Gavel • Fake money

### Introduction

A group of children from wealthy families decide to take a car ride around the city. Excited and careless, they begin to drive too fast. They ignore traffic lights, speed limits, and pedestrian crossings. What starts as a fun drive quickly turns into a lesson about honesty, responsibility, and the dangers of corruption.

### Scene 1 – The Reckless Ride

*(A sunny morning. The children are laughing and singing in the car.)*

**Children:** (singing and laughing) We're going fast, we're going free!

*(They speed through a red light and ignore stop signs. Nearby, a police officer notices them.)*

**Police Officer 1:** That car is speeding and didn't stop at the red light! I must stop them right now.

### Scene 2 – The First Stop

*(The police officer signals the car to stop.)*

**Police Officer 1:** Sir, please get out of the car and show me your documents.

**Driver:** I'm sorry, officer. I don't have a driver's license.

**Police Officer 1:** You were driving very fast without a license. That's dangerous and against the law. You'll need to pay a fine.

**Driver:** Please, officer... don't give us a fine. I'll give you some extra money instead.

*(The child hands over fake money. The officer accepts it.)*

**Police Officer 1:** Thank you, everything is fine now. You may go.



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*(The children drive off, laughing.)*

### Scene 3 – Justice on the Road

*(A second police officer spots the same car speeding again and pulls them over.)*

**Police Officer 2:** You're driving dangerously fast. I'm issuing you a fine.

**Driver:** Please don't fine me. I'll give you money, like the other officer did!

**Police Officer 2:** What? That's not right! It's illegal to offer or accept money to avoid punishment. Both you and the other officer have broken the law.

*(Police Officer 2 arrests both the driver and Police Officer 1.)*

**Police Officer 2:** This is corruption. You're both coming with me to court.

### Scene 4 – In the Courtroom

*(The judge sits at the desk. The arrested police officer and child stand before them.)*

**Judge:** We are here because you both broke the law. Officer, you accepted money instead of giving a fine. That is corruption—taking illegal money for personal gain. You have dishonored your duty and will be punished.

**Judge:** You are fined **2,500 leva** and sentenced to **six years in jail**.

**Judge (to the child):** You are also responsible for offering the bribe. You will pay a **500 leva fine**, and your right to drive is revoked for **two years**.

*(The police officer puts on handcuffs. The judge raises the gavel.)*

**Judge:** Corruption is illegal. Everyone must follow the law, no matter who they are.

*(The judge strikes the gavel. The lights go off.)*

### Moral of the Story:

Breaking the law and trying to buy your way out of trouble is wrong. Corruption hurts everyone. Honesty, fairness, and respect for the law are the foundation of a just society.



## Scenario: Crimes Against Environment and Nature

### Characters

- **Jovan** – Child
- **Aleks** – Child
- **Forester**
- **Parents**
- **Police Officers (1 & 2)**

### Scene 1 – A Family Day in Nature

*(A sunny afternoon. A family is spending the day outdoors in the forest, preparing food on a barbecue. The parents are busy cooking while Jovan and Aleks are playing nearby.)*

**Jovan:** Hey, Aleks! Let's collect some twigs!

**Aleks:** Why?

**Jovan:** Because we'll make our own barbecue!

**Aleks:** Wow, that's a great idea! But how?

**Jovan:** I saw where Mom left the lighter. I'll take it and we'll start!

**Aleks:** Yay! This will be fun!

*(The boys run off, collecting dry branches. They wander far from their parents and start a small fire. Within moments, the flames begin to spread toward a nearby fence in front of the forest ranger's house.)*

### Scene 2 – The Fire

*(The fire grows quickly. The boys panic. The Forester notices the smoke and runs toward them with a shovel.)*

**Forester:** Children! What have you done? Step back, quickly!

*(He throws soil over the flames until the fire goes out.)*

**Forester:** You must never light a fire in the forest! It's dangerous and against the law!

**Aleks:** We just wanted to play.

**Forester:** Play is fine—but not with fire! Who are you here with?

**Jovan:** With our parents.

**Forester:** Where are they?

*(Meanwhile, the parents realize the boys are missing.)*

**Parents:** Jooovan! Aleeeeks! Where are you?

**Jovan and Aleks:** Here, Mom! Here, Dad!

*(They run toward their parents. The Forester explains what happened.)*



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**Parents:** Thank goodness everything ended well. Thank you, Forester!

(To the children) You two must never do anything like this again—it's very dangerous!

**Forester:** That's right. You could have been hurt, and the entire forest could have burned down. Such acts are punished by law! But since you are children, your parents will have to pay a fine.

*(He takes out his phone.)*

**Forester:** I'll need to call the police and report this incident.

### Scene 3 – The Police Arrive

*(A few minutes later, two police officers arrive.)*

**Policeman 1:** What happened here? Who started the fire?

**Parents:** Our children did. They were trying to make their own barbecue. Luckily, the Forester was nearby and stopped it in time.

**Policeman 2:** It's good no one was hurt, but lighting fires in the forest is a serious offense. We must file an official report.

*(He writes down the details.)*

**Policeman 1:** The children are minors, so their parents will be responsible. A fine will be issued, and please make sure this never happens again.

*(The parents nod. The police hand over the report.)*

**Forester:** Remember, children—carelessness in nature can destroy forests and harm animals. Always be careful!

*(Jovan and Aleks look down, understanding their mistake.)*

### Moral of the Story

- Never play with fire — it can cause serious damage to nature and people.
- Always follow safety rules and respect the environment.
- Every act of carelessness in nature has consequences.
- Protecting forests means protecting our future.



## Scenario: Family Violence

### Theme: Criminal Offenses Against Marriage, Family, and Youth

#### Characters

- **Pavle** – Husband
- **Maria** – Wife
- **Gjorgi and Fanny** – Their children
- **Umut** – Police officer
- **Nefes** – Judge

#### Scene 1 – At Home

*(The street in front of Pavle's house. It's late evening. Pavle returns home drunk, singing loudly with a group of musicians following him.)*

**Pavle:** (singing and stumbling)  
*Hick... I drink wine or brandy,  
I ride my horse up and down...*

*(He laughs and stumbles toward the door. His wife, Maria, is waiting at the entrance, worried and angry.)*

**Maria:** Pavle! Every night it's the same. You come home drunk while your children wait for you. Don't you care about us?

**Pavle:** (shouting) Get out of my way, woman! Who are you to tell me what to do?

*(He pushes her. A fight begins — shouting, struggling, and crying. The children watch, terrified. Gjorgi quickly takes a phone and dials 192.)*

**Gjorgi:** (crying softly into the phone)  
Hello... Police? Please help! Dad is hurting Mom!

*(Moments later, a police car arrives. Officer Umut rushes in.)*

**Officer Umut:** Stop! Hands in the air!  
*(He separates Pavle from Maria and handcuffs him.)*  
Violence is not the answer. You're coming with us.

#### Scene 2 – The Police Station

*(Later that night.)*

Pavle sits in a cell, silent and regretful. The officers file a report to the court about the incident, including statements from Maria and the children.



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### Scene 3 – The Courtroom

*(The next day. Judge Nefes enters the courtroom and knocks the gavel.)*

#### **Judge Nefes:**

After reviewing the evidence and hearing the witnesses, this court finds that **Pavle Stojanov** committed physical, mental, and verbal abuse against his wife, **Maria Stojanova**, while intoxicated and in the presence of their two children.

Following the proposal of the Ministry of Internal Affairs, the court orders the following **protective measures**:

- You are forbidden to threaten or commit any act of domestic violence.
- You may not harass or disturb your wife or children in any way.
- You must stay at least **100 meters** away from their residence.
- You are required to attend **mandatory alcohol treatment**.

These measures will remain in effect for **12 months**, and may be extended if necessary.

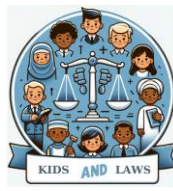
*(The judge looks at Pavle sternly.)*

## Scenario: Human Rights Violations

*(Theme: Discrimination – Race, Gender, Ethnicity)*

### Characters

- **Zara** – A young girl from Marrakech
- **Ivo** – A boy from the neighborhood
- **Naomi** – Zara’s mother
- **Dimitri** – Ivo’s father
- **Georgi** – Police officer
- **Eli** – Member of the Local Anti-Social Behaviour Committee
- **Judge Ivan**

### Scene 1 – In the Park

*(A sunny afternoon. Children are playing in the park. Zara and Ivo meet near the playground.)*

**Ivo:** Hi! What’s your name?

**Zara:** Hi, I’m Zara. What’s your name?

**Ivo:** I’m Ivo.

**Zara:** Do you want to play together?

**Ivo:** (hesitates, looking at her) Hmm... You look strange. You’re different. You’re... black.

*(Zara looks shocked and begins to cry.)*

**Zara:** Mommy, come here! Ivo said something mean to me because I’m different.

*(Naomi, Zara’s mother, stands up angrily from the bench. Ivo’s father, Dimitri, watches the scene unfold.)*

**Naomi:** Come, Zara. Let’s go and talk to his father.

*(They approach Dimitri.)*

**Naomi:** Hello, sir. Your son insulted my daughter because of the color of her skin. That’s not okay.

**Dimitri:** (raising his voice) We don’t want you here! You’re different. Go somewhere else to play!

*(Naomi feels deeply hurt and discriminated against. She calls the police.)*

### Scene 2 – The Police Arrive

*(Officer Georgi approaches.)*



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**Georgi:** Hello. What happened here?

*(Both parents start yelling at each other. Georgi raises his hand firmly.)*

**Georgi:** Please stop shouting. Calm down!

*(Dimitri pushes Naomi angrily.)*

**Georgi:** Sir, that's enough! You have violated this woman's human rights by using both verbal and physical aggression.

*(He handcuffs Dimitri and escorts him to the police station.)*

### Scene 3 – At the Police Station

Dimitri spends **24 hours** in custody. Officer Georgi prepares and submits a report to the court.

### Scene 4 – In the Courtroom

*(Judge Ivan enters the courtroom.)*

**Judge Ivan:** After reviewing the police report and witness statements, this court finds that **Dimitri** used both physical and verbal aggression.

You are sentenced to **one month in jail**.

*(Naomi later files an additional report with the Local Anti-Social Behaviour Committee.)*

**Eli (Committee member):** Based on the incident, Dimitri will also receive a **financial fine** for his actions.

### Conclusion

- No one has the right to **discriminate** against others.
- We are all **equal human beings**, deserving of respect and dignity.
- No one should ever be a **victim of verbal or physical aggression**.
- Understanding and kindness build stronger, fairer communities.



## Scenario: The Red Light

### Theme: Criminal Offenses Against Public Transport Safety

#### Characters

- **Anna** – A driver
- **Jim** – Another driver
- **Policeman**
- **Doctor**
- **Judge (The Red Light)**

#### Scene 1 – On the Street, Morning

*(A busy street. Anna is driving while her phone rings.)*

**Anna:** (answers phone while driving)

Hello, boss! Yes, I'm on my way... I know we have an important meeting. Don't worry, I'll be there soon!

*(While distracted, Anna doesn't see the red light. At that moment, Jim's car enters the intersection. The two cars crash.)*

**Jim:** (getting out, holding his arm)

What are you doing?! Didn't you see the red light?

**Anna:** (limping, frightened)

Oh no... I'm so sorry!

**Jim:** Sorry?! Look at my arm! I'm in pain—and my car is destroyed!

**Anna:** My car is damaged too, and my leg hurts. I didn't mean for this to happen!

**Jim:** (groaning) Aaaahhh!

**Anna:** I'll call an ambulance right now!

*(She dials emergency services.)*

**Jim:** And I'll call the police!

#### Scene 2 – Minutes Later

*(An ambulance arrives with the Doctor.)*

**Doctor:** Good morning, everyone. What happened here?

**Jim:** It's not such a good morning for me! My arm hurts badly.



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**Doctor:** Let me take a look. Please, sit down.  
*(He examines Jim's arm.)*

**Doctor:** I'm afraid you have a broken bone.

**Jim:** What?! My tennis tournament is tomorrow!

**Anna:** You're a tennis player? Oh no... I'm so sorry! *(starts crying)*

**Doctor:** Please, miss, sit down. You're injured too.  
*(He examines Anna.)*

**Doctor:** Bad news for you as well—you have a leg fracture.

**Anna:** Oh no... I've been training all year for my dance competition.

**Jim:** I'm sorry for you, but you must take responsibility.

### Scene 3 – The Policeman Arrives

**Policeman:** Good morning. Or maybe not such a good one. What happened here?

**Jim:** Officer, this lady ran a red light! Now I'm hurt, and my car is ruined.

**Policeman:** Miss, is that true?

**Anna:** Yes, officer. I wasn't careful—I was rushing to work and talking on the phone.

**Policeman:** That's no excuse. Distracted driving is dangerous.

**Jim:** She must face the consequences!

**Policeman:** Very well. Let's call the judge.

### Scene 4 – In the Courtroom

*(The Judge enters with authority.)*

**Judge:** Please, everyone, come closer.

Miss Anna, you ran a red light, caused an accident, and injured another person. How do you plead?

**Anna:** I admit, Your Honor... I'm guilty.

**Judge:** Thank you for your honesty.

Here is your sentence: you must pay for Mr. Jim's car repairs, and your driver's license will be suspended for **three months**. Case closed!

**Policeman:** Miss, please hand over your license.

*(Anna gives it to him. Music plays as the scene transitions.)*

### Scene 5 – Epilogue



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*(The Judge stands alone on stage.)*

### **Judge:**

When someone violates traffic rules and endangers others, that is a **criminal offense against public transport safety**.

Anyone who causes injury or major damage by ignoring road regulations can be fined or even imprisoned for up to **three years**.

*(The Judge raises the gavel and strikes it once.)*

### **Moral of the Story**

- Always obey traffic signals.
- Never use your phone while driving.
- One careless moment can hurt you and others.
- Responsibility on the road saves lives.
